If your child is due to start Primary school next year - September 2017 you need to apply online NOW. Please see the notice in the Nursery or on the Parents board for information or contact the office. You can make your application now but these must be made no later than 15th January 2017.

Allergies

Some children in school are allergic to nuts in all forms. A gentle reminder to all parents that nuts, including peanut butter etc. are not allowed in school. Please be aware when putting packed lunches together or sending in treats for children.

Jewellery

A reminder regarding school policy on jewellery. As a school we have a responsibility to ensure all children in our care are safe at all times. All jewellery,

including those worn for religious observance, poses a risk of injury. Only stud earrings are acceptable and no necklaces for obvious reasons. In P.E. we try to minimise the risk by asking that they be removed or made safe by covering with tape during all sporting activities.
