# Applying for Primary school place September 2017

If your child was born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2012 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2013 they are due to start Primary school in September 2017. You will need to apply online by **15<sup>th</sup> January 2017 at the latest**. If you pay your council tax to Nuneaton & Bedworth council then you should apply online via [www.warwickshire.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/admissions) or if you pay your council tax to Coventry - apply online at [www.coventry.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.coventry.gov.uk/admissions)
