If you pay your council tax to Nuneaton & Bedworth council then you should apply online via www.warwickshire.gov.uk/admissions or if you pay your council tax to Coventry - apply online at www.coventry.gov.uk/admissions

For children due to start school in September next year 2018, the deadline is 15th January 2018
