Parents' Evening

Parents' Evening this term will again take place in the school hall. You will be allocated a 10 minute slot to talk to your child's Teacher/Key Worker about their progress,

attainment and welfare. If you feel that you will need longer then you are encouraged to make another appointment at a different time. There will also be opportunities for you to look through your child's work in the classroom, there is no time restriction on this. Teaching Assistants will be available to speak to in the classroom too.

Also note that a separate Parents' Evening form will be needed to be returned for each child you have in school so that all staff are aware of every child in your family that attends the school from Nursery to Year 6. We can ensure that those of you with more than one child have appointments that are close together.

Nursery

The 'normal' nursery day runs from 8.45-2.45 (30 hour funded children) & 8.45-11.45/12.15-15.15 (15 hour funded children). We can accommodate children being dropped off earlier and picked up later. If you wish to drop off your child earlier than this time or collect them later this can be arranged, in advance, with Mrs Foxall and additional charges will apply.

Art Week

Each class has an art week during the Spring Term when they focus on studying a particular artist and art technique. We would like to invite parents in to come and support their child during an art afternoon. The children thoroughly enjoy experimenting and learning about art and artists and would love to share this with their family. A letter will be sent home advising parents of the dates and times so please make a note on your calendar - we would love your support. Please let your child's teacher know if you are able to attend so that we are able to accommodate numbers.
