Assembly focus

Each week we have a theme or focus for our assemblies which permeates the children's lessons and discussions for the week. Your children may come home with questions and thoughts/ideas about some of the discussions

that have taken place. I start the process on Monday with the first assembly and usually finish on Friday with another message on the same theme.

This week we have talked about the importance of **forgiveness**; we need to forgive others and accept that we need to be forgiven by others too. We then looked at, and read, 'The Lord's Prayer' together and discussed the word 'trespass' in the original version.

We will continue to remind the children that we should acknowledge our feelings of anger, upset and disloyalty but that we need to forgive our friends as we can all make mistakes.



Parents' Evening

Parents' Evening this term will again take place in the school hall. You will be allocated a 10 minute slot to talk to your child's Teacher/Key Worker about their progress, attainment and welfare. If you feel that you will need longer then you are encouraged to make another appointment at a different time. There will also be opportunities for you

to look through your child's work in the classroom, there is no time restriction on this. Teaching Assistants will be available to speak to in the classroom too.

Also note that a separate Parents' Evening form will be needed to be returned for each child you have in school so that all staff are aware of every child in your family that attends the school from Nursery to Year 6. We can ensure that those of you with more than one child have appointments that are close together.
