Specific breaktime and lunchtime activities will be provided by our Sports Apprentice so that all year groups will have a focussed activity for the week.

As a result of the wider range of activities offered to all year groups, there will be an increase in the numbers of children participating in the activities in school and we hope to encourage children to take up a variety of sports outside school. A Year 6 child from last year who is now in secondary school took part in our local Cross-country competitions, she is now representing her school and attending cross-country trials in Birmingham - we are very proud of her success.

With the introduction of our Sports Apprentice to add to our coaching team we feel that positive male role models will lead the activities. It is good for our children to have the opportunity to be taught by male teachers to prepare them for secondary school. We will continue to liaise with our secondary school partners President Kennedy, Coventry and Ash Green, Coventry for additional support.
