We will be:

Reading.

- Using reading comprehension skills to further our understanding of the text, including asking questions and using inference.
- We will be practising a sample test ready to take our SATS.

Writing.

- Following on from our work on *Leon and the Place Between*, we will be focussing our studies on non-fiction texts.
- writing non-chronological reports based on The Rabbit Problem and how to look after a rabbit.
- writing descriptions of characters.

Spelling.

- Learning contracted forms of verbs such as cannot = can't, adverbs,

Grammar.

- focussing on adverbs, noun phrases and suffixes.
- finding different ways of starting a sentence.

Maths

Number.

- We will be looking at numbers up to 100 and looking at their place value, including greater than and less than.
- We will be learning our 2,3, 5 and 10 times tables
- We will be learning about the operations multiplication and division, and using column addition and subtraction.
- We will be learning more about and comparing fractions of shape and number such as $1/2$, $1/4$ and $1/3$.

Other areas.

- We will be measuring using weight and temperature.
- We will be learning the time to o'clock, half past, quarter to and quarter past.
- We will be looking at different types of measurement such as capacity and the different units that they use.
- We will be taking a sample practice test in preparation for our SATS.
